Who are we? – Wer wir sind:

Facing History and Ourselves is an educational non-profit founded by a middle school teacher in 1976. We are non-political. We are focused on the prevention of genocide through education. We believe that teachers deserve to receive content-rich professional learning opportunities throughout their careers. Best classroom activities are designed by teachers who know their students. We believe that young people are “moral philosophers;” they can confront difficult history in the classroom with appropriate teaching and support.

Facing History and Ourselves ist eine gemeinnützige Bildungseinrichtung, die 1976 von einem Mittelschullehrer gegründet wurde. Wir sind politisch neutral. Wir konzentrieren uns auf die Prävention von Völkermord durch Bildung. Die besten Unterrichtsaktivitäten werden von Lehrern gestaltet, die ihre SchülerInnen kennen. Wir glauben, dass junge Menschen "Moralphilosophen" sind und dass sie in der Lage sind, sich mit schwieriger Geschichte im Klassenzimmer auseinanderzusetzen, falls sie angemessen unterrichtet und unterstützt werden.

How does it work?

Wie es abläuft:

- Teachers attend a either a short or long term professional development event – Lehrkräfte nehmen an einem kurz- oder langfristigen Ereignis zur Berufsbildung teil:
 - Workshop - usually 1-2 days – Workshop: üblicherweise 1-2 Tage
 - Seminar - usually 3-5 days - Seminar: üblicherweise 3-5 Tage
- Online workshops
- Program Associates provide educator support after training to integrate in the classroom – Programmassistenten helfen nach dem Training bei der Umsetzung im Klassenzimmer
